
A Three-Webinar PD Series on Leadership for School Improvement

Prior to this, he was associate superintendent of administrative services where he oversaw transportation, food and nutrition, graphics communication, information services, growth management, construction, maintenance/facilities, and technology. Kent has a doctorate in educational leadership and policy studies from Arizona State University. His Master of Education and Bachelor of Arts degrees are in Elementary Education from the University of Arizona.

21 February 2018

Session 1: The Focus of Leadership

A key role of school leaders is analyzing data and ensuring improvement efforts directly address the core challenges of the school. Using McREL's What Matters Most Framework, we will help leaders understand critical leverage points for change and the consistent, research-based pathways that all schools take to improve student outcomes. This helps participants identify classroom practices, school practices, and student supports needed to improve achievement.

20 March 2018

Session 2: Managing Change

Any change worth making is likely to encounter resistance. Effective leadership melts away resistance by understanding people's personal reasons for resisting, or embracing, change. Leaders learn to predict potential obstacles to change and proactively plan for change and engage stakeholders to achieve better results.

24 April 2018

Session 3: Developing a Purposeful Community

Research makes a strong case for collegiality and school communities coalescing around shared, moral purpose with a spirit of can-do optimism. Participants will engage in a variety of learning activities that prepare them to create a "purposeful community" committed to working together to achieve continuous improvement in their own schools, with a focus on instructional supports for all learners.
